Expanding Horizons: Reflecting on YPU's "rapid response" to Japan's call to world citizenship

In the late 1980's Japan's education ministry called upon the educators of Japan to raise up Japanese who are "capable of contributing to global peace." When Yamaguchi Women's University responded by restructuring to become a co-ed university (YPU) with a Faculty of Intercultural Studies, prefectural law had to be changed in order to hire foreign teachers.

This lecture will offer commendations and a few cautions regarding the profound and rapid changes of the past two decades, highlighting the university's expanding efforts toward that goal. Reflections of YPU's first non-Japanese professor will touch on how curriculum and policy changes, the growth of international programs, and the role of collaborative global research projects (including her own research in developmental assets for children) are contributing to widening the path toward world citizenship and global peace.
