4. Affiliation	Faculty of Intercultural Studies, Department of Intercultural Studies The new teacher may be transferred to another department which is closer to his or her field of specialization.

Qualifications	<ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) Qualified applicants should have a Master's Degree, or an academic degree equivalent to MA, or teaching and research experiences that are comparable to MA or higher academic degrees.(2) Those who have academic achievements in the field of English education, either in English or in Japanese.(3) Those who are able to incorporate CALL and e-learning into their classes.(4) Those who are able to conduct classes in English.(5) Those who have enough proficiency in Japanese so that they can successfully perform their jobs related to classes, in-school meetings and communication with students and staff members.(6) Those who do not fall within any of the categories of ineligibility set out in Article 9 of the School Education Law, Japan.(7) Those who are going to live in Yamaguchi City or in neighboring areas so that they can easily commute to Yamaguchi Prefectural University.

8. Application Deadline	<p>July 28th, 2017</p> <p>The submission documents must be mailed by this date.</p>
9. Selection Procedure	<p>(1) Primary selection is based on documents submitted by applicants, the results of which will be reported in written form to each of them by the end of September. Only those who pass the primary selection are considered in secondary selection, which takes place in October.</p> <p>(2) Secondary selection is based on interview, the results of which will be reported in written form to each interviewee by the end of November.</p> <p>(3) Those who pass primary selection will be informed of the date and method of secondary selection.</p> <p>(4) Applicants have to pay the money necessary for secondary selection, transport expenses and hotel fees, for example.</p>
10. Conditions of Employment	<p>(1) Yamaguchi Prefectural University complies with the official regulations of Yamaguchi Prefectural University as to the salaries and working conditions employees.</p> <p>(2) The new teacher has a tenured position, and the official retirement comes at the age of 65.</p> <p>(3) If the new teacher is transferred to Yamaguchi Prefectural University from a national or another public university, the length of service that they have with their previous university is not counted in the calculation of their retirement money when they leave Yamaguchi Prefectural University.</p>
