Research Room: American Culture and Society Teacher: Amy Wilson, Professor Theme: Cross-cultural understanding and research

The focus of this seminar is on cross-cultural understanding. We will discuss readings in English about the subject in order to understand the fundamental differences between cultures and what needs to be done to overcome these and develop our mutual appreciation, using mainly information based on American culture and society. Students will be expected to have good attendance, participate in lively discussions, and work on some sort of active research involving surveys and/or interviews, as well as doing extensive library and internet research. The main geographical areas of focus are Japan and the United States, but other areas can be considered.

Grades will be based on active class participation, reporting skills and an English research report of over 5 pages in length with bibliography .

Weekly classes will be used mainly for discussion – Students will take turns preparing and leading the class. We will learn about general themes of cross-cultural understanding, and also begin work on students' graduation theses.
