1 Program Purpose and Goals

The exchange program between Yamaguchi Prefectural University and other universities around the world allows students from each university to spend from 1 to 2 semesters at the other university and to take courses that are recognized for credit at the home institution.

The main goal of the exchange program here at YPU is to provide exchange students with as many opportunities as possible to both interact with Japanese students and people in the community as well as experience many aspects of a more traditional way of life in Japan.

The courses available for exchange students at YPU include Japanese for Non-natives, academic classes taught in English and experiential courses in Japanese arts, culture, and sports. Exchange students may also take courses offered for the Japanese undergraduate and graduate students if their Japanese comprehension is good enough.

2 Other Activity

- 1) Exchange students will participate in the Community Exchange program at least twice
- 2) Exchange students will participate in the two-night Homestay or Home visit during their stay

- 1)Must take Japanese Language course (Total of 4 credits)
- 2)May take courses from the Cultural & Experiential list, but Physical Education Credits are not acceptable for credit at BU
- 3) Must take a total of over 14 credits to qualify for visa
